Families Anonymous (FA) is a free self-help program for those concerned about the drug/alcohol abuse and related behavioral problems of a relative or friend. It is completely anonymous, non-professional and non-religious. There are no dues and no fees; it is not connected with any hospital or agency.

Individuals concerned with another's abuse of drugs or related problems of living, when gathered together for mutual aid, may call themselves a Families Anonymous (FA) Group, provided that, as a group, they have no other affiliation. The only requirement for membership is a concern about the use of mind-altering substances or related behavioral problems of a relative or friend.

Each group has but one primary purpose, to help those concerned with someone who may have a problem with drug/alcohol abuse or dependence. We do this by practicing the Twelve Steps of this program, by encouraging and understanding those affected by this illness, and by welcoming and giving comfort to the families and friends of individuals with a current, suspected or former drug/alcohol problem.
