Each group has but one primary purpose, to help those concerned with someone who may have a problem with drug/alcohol abuse or dependence. We do this by practicing the Twelve Steps of this program, by encouraging and understanding those affected by this illness, and by welcoming and giving comfort to the families and friends of individuals with a current, suspected or former drug/alcohol problem.
